Mission Trip



FUMC "Mission Team" to Biloxi, Mississippi

Having gone to Moss Point, Mississippi following Hurricane Katrina three years ago, I was able to see first hand the destruction that a hurricane brings. Houses removed from their foundation, trees blown down, blue tarps on nearly every remaining rooftop. Thousands of families were living in small trailers provided by the FEMA. During my week there with a team from the Winston-Salem District, we worked together to re-shingle the rooftop of one house and worked to repair the interior of another house as well. Upon leaving, we realized that it would take years of work by many organizations to get things back to "normal".

Last year a team from FUMC Mocksville stayed at Camp Hope for a week and worked hard to help the people still recovering from Katrina in the Biloxi, Mississippi area. I have enjoyed learning of their experiences while they were there. In fact, I learned that there have been several mission teams from FUMC to volunteer in Mississippi over the past three years.

In just two weeks (Sept. 13-19), FUMC will be sending another "mission team" to the Biloxi, Mississippi area to continue in assistance of the recovery. After a day of traveling in our church bus to Biloxi, we will arrive at "Camp Love" and will also be eating our meals there during the week. We have yet to learn our assignment, but look forward to helping again in the recovery process. As with every "mission team", we know that we ourselves will be "blessed" by our experience, as we work, worship, and make new friends in the process.

According to team leader John Cottle, there are still couple of spots open if someone from FUMC would like to take part in the "work team". It will be an experience you are not likely to forget.

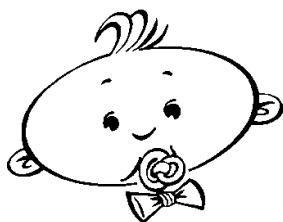

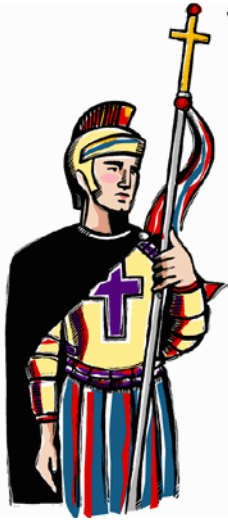

Many people today don't want to believe in the devil anymore. Even many people who say they are Christians don't believe in the reality of Satan. But he is alive and well on planet earth, attempting to destroy the work of Jesus Christ whenever he can. God's love is the foundation of our faith and it is very important in these troubling times that we understand the armor that God has provided for His people's protection. Each piece has a specific role it plays in our lives as believers. We live in a physical world but we face a spiritual war of the supernatural everyday of our lives...the battleground is our minds. 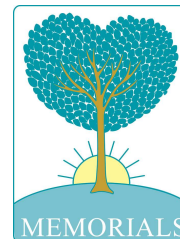
