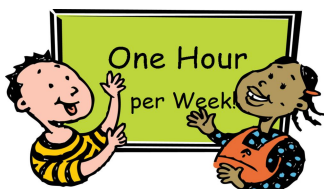

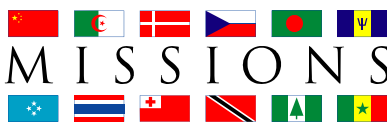

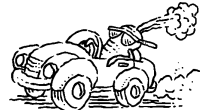

FOOD DRIVE

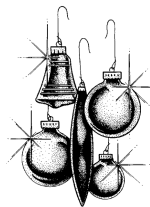
