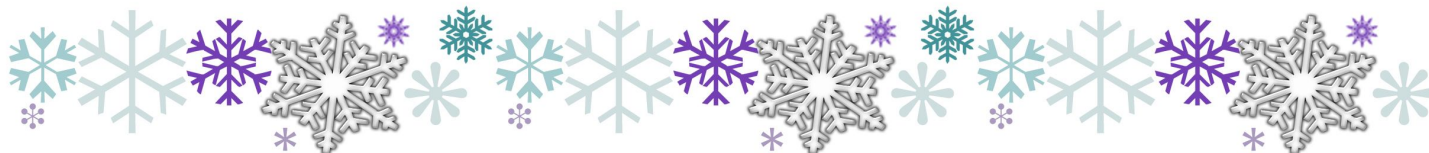

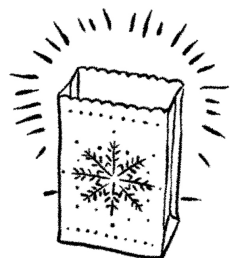

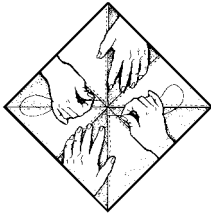

Christmas UMW Dinner

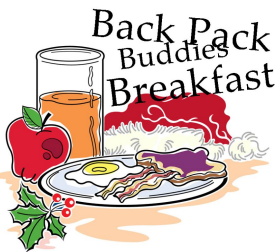

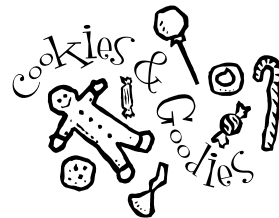
