Western NC Conference Building Teams — Do They Need You?

It's truly better to give than receive. Traveling thousands of miles to provide a service to others is truly a gift. Building Team veterans often say they end up receiving far more than they give because of fresh insights and new friendships. Teams usually work six weekdays and Sunday is kept for worship. Worship with the folks you are working with is an experience in itself.

Cost is typically from \$1,000 to \$2,000. Deadline for applications is usually mid-October. Building Teams rely on a core of skilled construction workers, but have tasks for all members. What's more important is a positive attitude and the willingness to pitch in wherever to accomplish tasks.

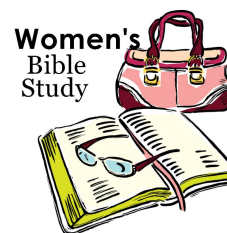
