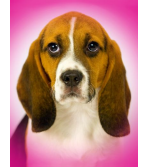

## Prayers & Squares

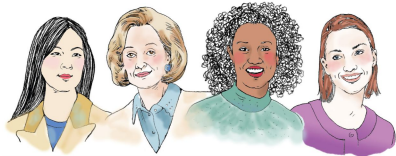
would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for your support this year with donations, memorials and support of our fellowship meals. October 19th will be our last meal for this year and we will be drawing for
