FUMC "Reaches Out"

Thursday evening, October 6, the church van, (driven by Taylor Slye), and pulling the disaster trailer, departed for Holland's United Methodist Church in Raleigh for a work project at Sunny Brook Mobile Home Park.

We were met Thursday night at Holland's UMC, by the assistant pastor and two lay members. They gave us a tour of the facilities and gave us the freedom to sleep in any classroom and the use of their cooking and showering facilities. They were very appreciative of our being there to help at Sunny Brook.

Sunny Brook Mobile Home Park was one of the areas that suffered a large amount of damage when the tornado in the spring hit the Raleigh area. Numerous trailers were destroyed or damaged and four lives were lost. It was our task to prime and paint two of these residences. Sunny Brook has a large percentage of Hispanic families. We assisted two of these families. One family was a young couple and two small children and the other family was a couple with three children. The father of the three children was diagnosed with cancer three years ago and has gone through chemotherapy, radiation, and stem cell replacement.

As we were packing up to return on Saturday evening, the Sr. Pastor came to meet us and thank us again for coming. Holland's UMC has a unique founding father. If you want to know about him, just ask Taylor. He stopped at the church cemetery on the way home to read Mr. Holland's tombstone. (Way to go Taylor!)

Members of the team were Giff Basham, Mike and Sally Brill, John and Shirley Cottle, Taylor and Kathy Slye, and Walt Wilson.
