First UMC Mocksville 2011 “Safe Sanctuary” Policy (to be in compliance with Western NC Conference)

- 1) Two or more adults should be present to oversee any church activity involving children or youth (Sunday School, Children’s Church, UMYF, Kid’s Choir, trips, etc). If one adult is present in the room, another adult must be close by to “look in” during class time.
- 2) Doors to classrooms involving children and youth should be partially open unless there is a see through window in the door.
- 3) All adults in leadership with youth should be at least 5 years older than the oldest youth.
- 4) No volunteers under the age of 18 are allowed to assist with children unless there is an authorized adult leader present in the room. Hired “sitters” should also be 18 yrs or older.
- 5) All volunteers volunteering with children or youth at church must attend First UMC Mocksville six months prior to volunteering.
- 6) No volunteers with sexual abuse / criminal record history (i.e. felony issues), or alcohol / substance abuse issues will be allowed to work with children / youth at the church.
- 7) Overnight trips for children and youth should have both male and female adults present. Youth of the opposite sex are not to sleep in the same room during a “lock-in” or sleepover.
- 8) “Individual” pictures and names of children or youth should not be posted on church websites.
- 9) Church insurance should include “liability”, including sexual abuse / misconduct coverage.
- 10) Children or youth should not sit in the front seats of church bus / van with adult drivers. An adult male driver should not drive / ride alone with a female child or youth who is unrelated.
- 11) There should be appropriate interpersonal boundaries between children, youth and adult workers. (example: no female child or youth should sit on the lap of a male adult).
- 12) Workers with children or youth should communicate off site trip details in advance to their parents. Trips overnight require adult signatures and health /medical emergency information.
- 13) Church staff working with children / youth should be trained in basic CPR and First Aid.
- 14) Church staff who counsel with children / youth should do so with a door at least partially opened (and another adult close by if possible).
- 15) Pastors / Youth Directors should be trained regarding cyber safety (social media, cell phone, texting, web-site access, etc.). Adults working with youth should provide only basic information of events, etc. when “texting” or communicating by computer (facebook, e-mail) with youth.
- 16) No one under the age of 21 should be allowed to drive the church van or bus. No adult with a DUI conviction should be allowed to drive the church van or bus.
- 17) Criminal background checks will take place for all church staff working with children / youth.
- 18) All workers and volunteers with children and youth at First UMC should be made aware of these “safe sanctuary” policies and must “agree” by word and action to follow them.
- 19) Suspected child abuse at First UMC should be reported to the Dept. of Social Services or Law Enforcement (making the church office aware or any reports which take place).

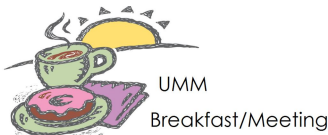

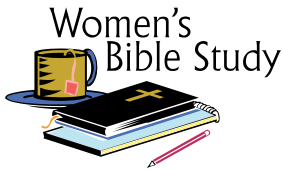
